

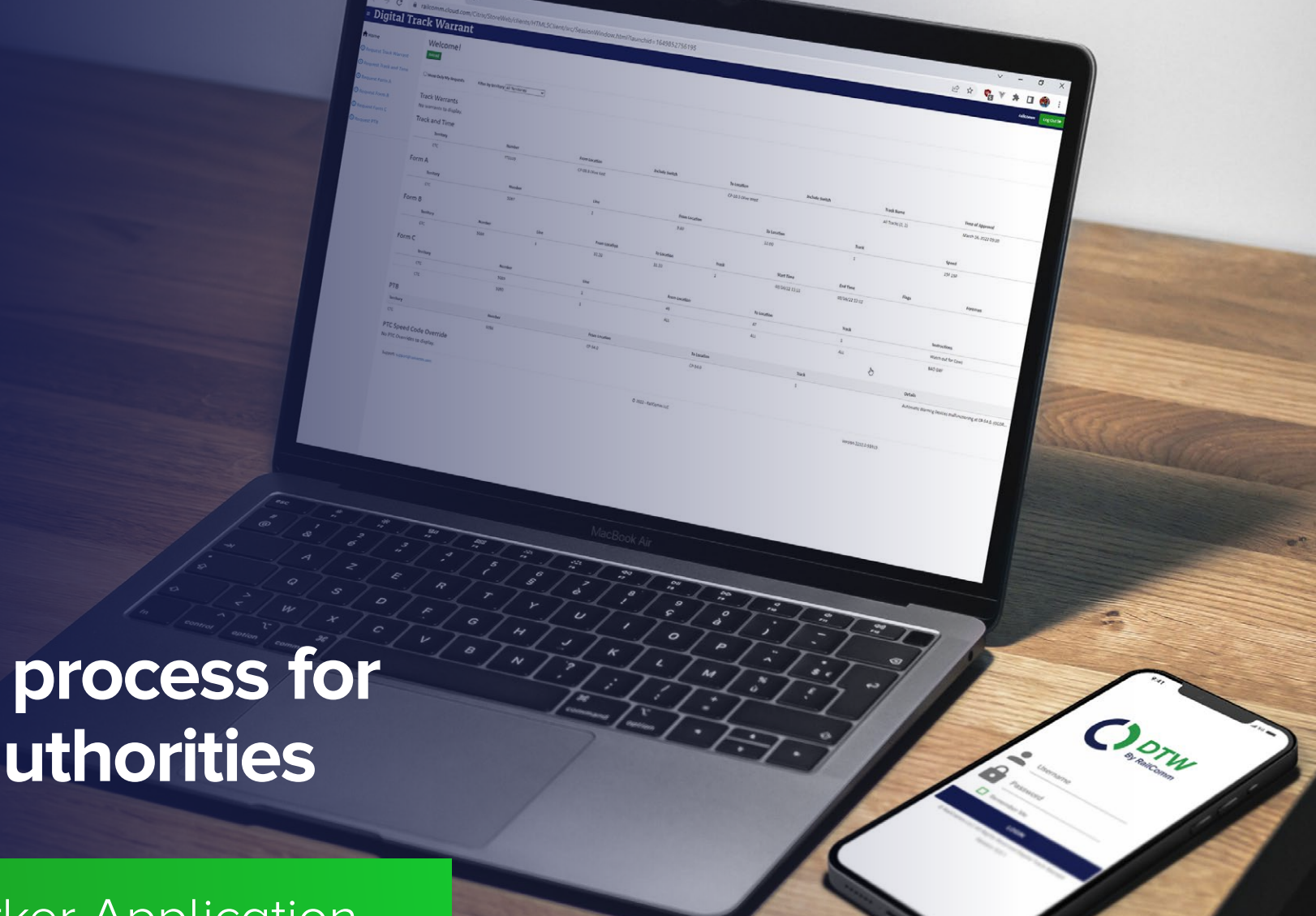

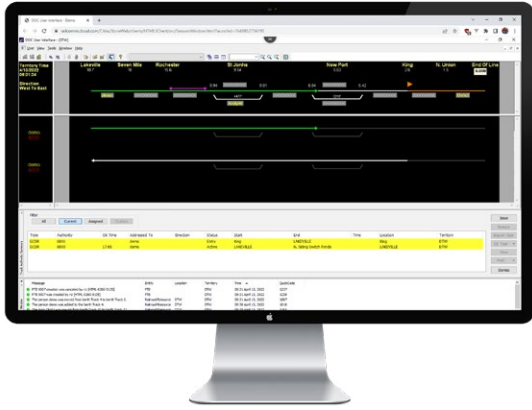

Digital Track Warrant

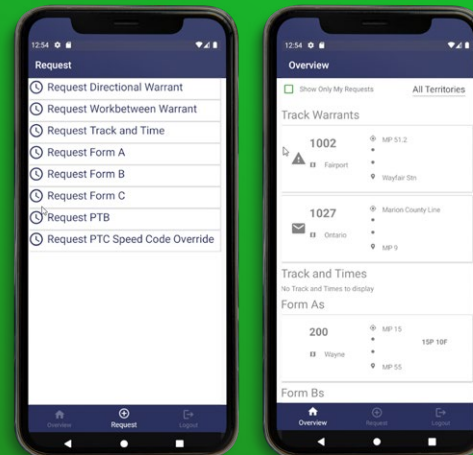


Digital Track Warrant provides an alternative to voice communication for work crews to request, modify and release their track authorities. Instead of coordinating a time for the work crew and dispatcher to verbally communicate with each other, a digital data exchange occurs at times that are the most convenient for each party. DTW also ensures that the data exchanged is both accurate and secure.

Features

- Mobile and Web-based applications accessible on any laptop or tablet with internet access
- Hosted in the Microsoft Azure Cloud
- Seamless integration with RailComm's DOC® Dispatch System
- Digital transmission can be bypassed for traditional voice requests at any time
- Digital in-form message exchange available between the dispatcher and field employee
- Track warrants are issued after DOC System validation and conflict checking processes
- Application web page does not time-out during loss of connectivity
- Field employee selects location and limits of the authorization
- DOC System auto-fills pre-existing track bulletins and other special instructions
- Dispatcher confirms limits and the use of additional lines
- All messages must be acknowledged by recipient
